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
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INDEPENDENT INDIA THE JOURNEY AHEAD

73 years ago, India the home of one of the world's oldest and most influential civilizations got independence on August 15, 1947 from the imperialist rule of the British Empire. It suffered in the dastardly clutches of slavery and servitude for the past two hundred years. The first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru delivered his seminal 'Tryst with destiny' speech in the official ceremony held at the Constituent Assembly in Delhi, heralding the dawn of a new era in the long history of India. An Independent India was born with modern outlook, vision, dreams and destiny to prosper and excel in every realm of life. A nation awoke that night with a pledge to serve its people and mankind. A nation arose to become the growth engine of the world in the 21st century.

Since 1947, India has achieved immense progress in raising growth, income levels and standards of living. It is estimated that the Gross Domestic



Product (GDP) was about Rs. 2,939 billion during 1950-51 which increased to Rs 56,330 billion during 2011-12 (2004-05 constant prices). In 2018-19, India's GDP was valued at an estimated Rs. 1,40,776 billion (2011-12 constant prices). The present government under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi has set a target of making India a five trillion dollars economy by 2024.

At the onset of the Independence, the

country was haunted by the dreadful images of famines. No less than 20 lakhs people had died of hunger and starvation in one of the world's worst famines, the Bengal famine of 1943. India had acute shortage of food-grains to feed its population. The country fulfilled the task of food sufficiency and food security in the first thirty years of its independence by successfully implementing Green Revolution. The self-sufficiency was also

achieved by the country in dairy products and this achievement is termed as the White Revolution. India became one of the leading agricultural nations of the world.

The present government has taken a slew of measures like Pradhan Mantri KISAN Samman Nidhi or PM-KISAN Scheme, e-NAM, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana, Soil Health Card Scheme to further develop the primary sector and empower farmers of the country. The agricultural budget has increased from Rs. 25-30 thousand crores before 2014 to Rs. One lakh fifty thousand crores. The Government has set an ambitious target to double the income of farmers by 2022. Under the PM KISAN scheme, Rs. 75,000 crores are being transferred to the farmers' bank accounts through Direct Benefit Transfer. In a visionary step to transform agriculture and raising farmers'

EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES OFFER NEW CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

When the internet was invented, nobody thought that it would grow in the size that we see today. Many technologies that had humble beginnings have proved immensely useful for the world and its people. The internet has led to many applications, though initially it came as World Wide Web to connect all computers of the world to share information, pictures etc.

While innovating and exploring new things, we come across new technologies and applications which are able to bring efficiency, speed, accuracy and many more benefits.

Artificial Intelligence: Artificial Intelligence (AI) is the most talked about among the emerging technologies. It has been in existence since decades but is termed emerging as many new dimensions of its usage have come out recently. Industry 4.0 will largely be driven by automation and artificial Intelligence shall be making significant contribution to it. Intelligence is defined as mental ability-reasoning, problem-solving, learning and

unlearning. In its general nature intelligence integrates cognitive functions attention, memory, perception, language, planning. The human brain carries natural intelligence which of course differs from person to person. When a machine, device or system is made capable of adopting some of human intelligences, it is said to be making use of AI. Thus AI is a combination of technology and intelligence under which computer systems made of machines and software, are able to perform tasks that normally require human intelligence. AI may be applied to a broad range of domains and applications. The core idea is to build machines and algorithms which are capable of performing computational tasks that would otherwise require human like brain functions.

Considering the scope of AI application, concerns are being raised if it will replace humans thereby leading to job losses. Opinions are divided on this. It is pretty sure that in many jobs AI will be applied and some functions will definitely be taken over but it'll be creating new jobs as well.



It is the same misplaced fear that gripped industries and businesses with the advent of computerization. Also, AI can never be as creative as humans.

Recognising the present interest in AI and its future prospects, Central Board of Secondary Education has decided to incorporate this in its curriculum. NITI Ayog has formulated a national strategy for adoption of artificial intelligence.

Big Data Analytics: Today we daily encounter unprecedented volume of data. Also the data which we're exposed to, is relatively more organised. In its primary

form, data can be just one or one set of numbers, however deep down it may have meaningful implications and usage for businesses.

In data science, every transaction creates a data or a set of data. For example if you made an online purchase-the set of data includes what you purchased, at what price and time, is it a new purchase or a repeat one; if latter after how much gap it was purchased etc. By analysing such data from individual

and group of customers, businesses may plan their production or marketing strategies. Data Analytics has grown into a vast subject now and covers various forms of analytics such as prescriptive, predictive etc.

Analytics has extensive uses in human resource planning, sales and marketing management, banking and finance, education etc.

Indian firms, like their global counterparts have realized that a proper analytics strategy has a direct link to business performance. As per recent estimates India is currently among the top 10 big data analytics markets in the world. With its huge population, India can greatly benefit from big data analytics by way of better civic governance, social security and financial inclusion. Such analytics can be a catalyst for the economy and country at large.

Blockchain: Some of you might have heard about blockchain in regard to cryptocurrency like bit coin. Technological experts see blockchain as a decentralised, secure, cost effective and efficient way to make and track transactions electronically. Blockchain can enable ease of collaboration for enterprises and ease of living for citizens by bringing in transparency across government and private sector interfaces. It is very often combined with technologies such as AI or Internet of Things. Unlike other technologies, which have the potential to deliver completely new services to citizens and other stakeholders alike, blockchain has the potential to revamp existing processes to unlock new sources of efficiency and value. Blockchains lead to a system that seamlessly adheres to the rule and fulfils the promise of not allowing transactions that did not comply with the agreed conditions. Today, people transact with multiple entities every day, both offline or online, and in a variety of forms. Transactions could be done in the form of small purchases from a roadside vendor or a deal between two very large organizations. Immaterial of the size or nature, however, a common underlying feature of transactions is that they require the parties involved to trust each other, or adhere to a system that enables this trust to be executed. These 'trust systems' can take a variety of forms, depending on the nature of transactions being executed, to create checks and balances to ensure that parties

involved fulfil their responsibilities and recourse in the case of disagreements is available. Blockchain is one of the most in demand hard skills for 2020. In 2019 the worldwide spending on blockchain stood at \$2.7 billion. Blockchain has become a line of business for top global companies in finance and technology domain like Amazon, J P Morgan, IBM, ORACLE, and Microsoft. Block chain can perform thousands of transactions per second with precision and accuracy. This is a relatively new technology but is catching up fast.

Internet of Things (IoT): Connecting devices to internet is getting common day by day. Such connections provide amazing benefits. Now many people watch videos (available on websites) on their TV sets for which they earlier used desktop, laptop or mobile phone. This is just one basic example of IoT. It is full of possibilities which we'll see in coming days. Many of the technology experts value IoT as a concept rather than a technology.

When something is connected to the internet that means that it can either send information or receive information, or can do both. This ability to send and/or receive information makes things smart. To become smart, a device doesn't need to have super storage or a supercomputer inside it. All a device has to do is connect to super storage or to a super computer. Being connected creates a number of new opportunities. By using IoT a mobile phone may be connected to a fridge, air conditioners, lighting system or locking system etc.

IoT devices are becoming more affordable day by day. In business organizations the increased adoption of IoT is due to low cost sensors, improved infrastructure and advancement of communication technology. When 5G technology arrives, it is likely to give another boost to IoT. The flagship programmes of Government of India like, Smart Cities Project, Digital India Programme, and Smart Energy Project are expected to expand the deployment of IoT. Nasscom expects that by end of this year IoT market in the country will be around 15 billion US\$.

Robotics: A robot is an assembled device to perform specific functions, hitherto being performed by human beings. In a sense a robot is a personification of AI and a tool for industrial automation. Robotics is the science of building robots and adding new features to them.

Use of robots help to achieve higher level of automation. We're getting more familiar with robots in our daily lives.

Robots come with different capabilities. There are simple robots which can move things from one place to other in a programmed way and there are those performing complex surgeries at hospitals. You'll find them in different shapes and sizes. Robots are an example of what a combination of engineering and technologies can do. Engineering involves designing various parts and aligning them. Technology is what drives a robot to perform its functions. Sensors make sure that these don't collide on their way. New technologies are helping robots to sense the world in ways far beyond the human capabilities.

Robots do work by making use of artificial intelligence combined with others. They can talk to you and guide you. Manufacturing industry has already been using robots in their assembly lines and other functions. Now a days they are increasingly being used in service industry. You may find them in a bank branch welcoming customers or answering queries at e-Commerce and other websites. Robotics is made use of in driverless cars to satellites. In this time of Corona epidemic, new models of robots are being used to spray disinfectants, sanitize and other purposes.

Education and Training

To study any of the above technology and get trained in it, you've to make careful choices. Courses related to above are not as easily available as general courses in engineering (B.E/ B.Tech) and management (MBA) etc. You need to choose a course which offers adequate learning with both theoretical and practical inputs. There are a number of online courses some free and some highly priced. Those who are completely new to the subject may go through the content of a free Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) to decide whether they want to go deeper into it and consider it as their area of work.

For engineering graduates, the emerging technologies offer opportunity to pursue further or higher study. Their background in mathematics and engineering makes it easier for them to understand machine learning and things like that. To study and work in emerging technologies, you need to have matching aptitude and orientation. Maximum number of courses are available in big data analytics both as a discipline of engineering or management. This means one may go for a B.Tech/ M.Tech or MBA/ BBA in

this subject.

Established in Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) has made phenomenal contribution in research and development related to new technologies. It is also a leading education/ training provider in emerging technologies. Few of its courses are mentioned below:

- ♦ Post Graduate Diploma in Internet of Things
- ♦ Post Graduate Diploma in Big Data Analytics
- ♦ PG Diploma in Artificial Intelligence

C-DAC also conducts MBA and MCA courses. It has centres at Noida, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Thiruvananthapuram, Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Pune, Silchar and Mohali.

National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), established by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, through its various centres (at Aurangabad, Calicut, Chandigarh, Kohima etc.), conducts a number of courses relevant to the areas mentioned in this article. Online courses include- Certified AI Professional, Big Data Analytics Tools, Tools for IoT Deployment among others. Advanced Diploma in Big Data Analytics and Advanced Diploma in Artificial Intelligence are among short duration (12-16 weeks) courses.

Various centres of Indian Institution of Information Technology (IIIT) have tried to cover emerging technologies in their under-graduate and postgraduate engineering courses. At postgraduate level specialisation in these may also be available. For example IIT, Delhi offers M.Tech with specialisation in Algorithms and Complexity which may be considered related to Big Data Analytics.

Indian Institution of Information Technology (IIIT) with centres at Allahabad, Gwalior, Nagpur, Pune etc is a good place to study emerging technologies as these specialise in information technology. Take the case of Atal Bihari Institute of Information Technology where B.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering has electives in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, Data Science and IoT. At IIIT, Pune M.Tech. is available with specialization in Artificial Intelligence and IoT. IIIT, Bengaluru in its M.Tech course in Computer Science and Engineering has credit in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning.

National Institute of Technology (NIT) centres too have courses related to emerging technologies.

All India Council for Robotics and Automation has Robotics Literacy Programs (RLP) at 'O', 'A' and 'B' levels. It also has the following Certification Programs

- ♦ Certificate in Artificial Intelligence (AI Beginners).
- ♦ Advance Certificate in Artificial Intelligence.
- ♦ Certificate in Internet of Things
- ♦ Certificate in Big Data & Hadoop.

Some of the IITs and IIITs have the opportunity to study robotics at postgraduate level.

Many start-ups too have started courses in IoT, Big Data, Blockchain etc. Usually these are off campus programmes.

Job opportunities

Newer job opportunities are coming up in all the above areas. You may choose to work with companies which are into developing applications related to these technologies. Many such companies, including start-ups are involved into this. The other option is to work as a practitioner. Here you may work with consumer durable companies, automobile manufacturers, banks, insurance companies and financial institutions, management, human resource and general consultancy firms, audit firms, aircraft manufacturers, airlines, software and hardware producers, market research agencies etc. Organizations like DRDO, UIADI, Indian Computer Emergency Response Team may also require your services. Teaching and research are other options.

NATIONAL

■ SC gives equal inheritance right to daughters from 1956

In a landmark judgment, Supreme Court has ruled that daughters will have inheritance rights equal to those of sons from properties of fathers and grandfathers right from the codification of the law in 1956. A bench of Justices Arun Mishra, S Abdul Nazeer and MR Shah cleared the confusion arising from the apex court's conflicting interpretations of the amended Section 6 of Hindu Succession Act, which came into force from September 9, 2005. The bench said whether the father is alive or not, daughters born before September 9, 2005, too can claim equal right in inheritance. The apex court said, daughters cannot be deprived of their right to equality conferred by Section 6 of the Act. The apex court was answering a reference based on conflicting decisions given by past verdicts of the top court. Although the amendment was applicable to Hindu daughters as coparceners who died after coming of the Act, there was no clarity on whether it will have retrospective effect.

■ 5 Member Team to Probe Kozhikode Aircraft Crash

Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau has ordered probe into the Air India Express aircraft crash at Kozhikode airport. The investigation of the aircraft crash will be done by a five member team headed by Captain S S Chahar. The team will investigate and determine the probable causes and contributory factors leading to the accident. It will also make recommendations to avoid such recurrences in the future. Investigator in-charge Captain S S



Chahar will submit his report within 5 months. An Air India Express flight from Dubai with over 190 people, skidded off the tabletop runway during landing at the Kozhikode airport in heavy rains, killing 18 people on 7th of this month.

■ Covid Test for Civil Service Examinees 'Fake News': UPSC

Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) has rejected claims made in a news report which stated that applicants appearing for Civil Services Prelims examination this year will have to get tested for COVID-19. The fake media reports said that only upon being tested negative the applicants would be allowed to appear for the examination. UPSC has clarified that it has not given any such instruction. Applicants have been urged not to believe unverified news reports and fact check any dubious information from the commission's website at www.upsc.gov.in



■ Centre Ensuring Free, Steady Supply of COVID Medical Supplies to States, UTs

Besides augmenting COVID-care facilities, the Centre has been providing medical supplies free of cost to the State and Union Territory governments to supplement their efforts. Most of the products supplied by the Government of India were not being manufactured in the country in the beginning. The rising global demand due to the pandemic resulted in their scarce availability in the foreign markets. With the combined efforts of Ministry of Health, Ministry of Textiles and Ministry of Pharmaceuticals, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Defence Research and Development Organisation and others, the domestic industry has been encouraged and facilitated to manufacture and supply essential medical equipment like PPEs, N95 masks, ventilators etc during this period. As a result, resolve for 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' and 'Make in India' has been strengthened and most of the supplies made by the Union Government are domestically manufactured.

ECONOMY

■ PM Unveils 'Transparent Taxation-Honoring the Honest'

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has unveiled 'Transparent Taxation - Honoring the Honest' platform. He said it will strengthen the efforts of reforming and simplifying India's tax system. This is part of the next phase of direct tax reforms aimed at



easing compliance and rewarding honest taxpayers to boost Indian economy. Prime Minister said, amidst all the reforms introduced by Centre, the number of people who have filed income tax returns has increased by about two-and-a-half crores in the last 6-7 years. He, however, said it is also true that in a country of 130 crores, the actual number of tax payers are still very less.

■ Import Embargo on 101 Defence-Related Items to Boost Indigenisation

In a big push to the Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative, the Defence Ministry has introduced an import embargo on 101 items beyond the given timeline to boost indigenisation of defence production. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said this decision will offer a great opportunity to the Indian defence industry to manufacture the items in the embargoed list by using their own design and development capabilities.

■ India Sustains World Food Supply Chain Amid Covid-19

During the difficult time of COVID 19 pandemic, India has sustained the world food supply chain and has continued with exports. The agricultural export during March-June 2020 increased by 23.24 percent compared to last year. Agriculture sector grew by 2.9 percent during 2019-20 as against 2.74 percent in 2018-19. Agri exports are expected to increase from 40 billion dollars to 60 billion by 2022.

■ Infrastructure Fund to Boost Agri Product Marketing

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched one lakh crore rupees agriculture infrastructure fund to give a leg up to post-harvest management and marketing of agricultural produce. The scheme will provide better warehousing and cold storage facilities for farmers while creating new jobs in rural areas. Prime Minister said, the scheme will enable startups to scale up their operations and India to build a global presence in organic and fortified food. The fund was launched with 1,128 crore rupees of new loans disbursed to more than 2,200 cooperative societies. During the event, the Prime Minister also transferred 17,100 crore rupees to more than 8.5 crore farmers under the PM-Kisan direct income assistance scheme.

INTERNATIONAL

■ India to Fund Maldivian Connectivity Project

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar has announced that India will fund the implementation of Greater Male Connectivity Project through a 400 million dollar Line of Credit and 100 million dollar grant. This 6.7 kilometre bridge project connecting Male with Gulhifalhu Port and Thilafushi industrial zone will help revitalise and transform Maldivian economy. The External Affairs Minister announced that regular cargo ferry service between India and Maldives will be started to boost trade and commerce. India is also starting an air travel bubble with Maldives to sustain and promote the dynamic people-to-people ties between the two countries.

■ Joe Biden Picks Indian Origin Senator Kamala Harris as Running Mate

In the United States, Democratic Presidential nominee Joe Biden has named Indian-origin senator Kamala Harris as his Vice-Presidential running mate. Kamala Harris is currently the US Senator from California. Former US President Barack Obama has



often described her as a trailblazer. If elected, Kamala Harris would be the first ever woman to be the Vice President of the United States and the first ever Indian-American and African Vice President of the country. Daughter of an Indian mother and a Jamaican father, Harris has known many firsts. She has been a county district attorney; the district attorney for San Francisco - the first woman and first African-American and Indian-origin to be elected to the position.

SPORTS

■ ICC T-20 World Cup: India to Host 2021 Event, Australia Gets 2022

International Cricket Council has confirmed that India will host the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2021 as planned. Meanwhile, ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2020 that was postponed due to Covid-19 will be held in Australia in 2022. Cricket's governing body has also decided to postpone the



ICC Women's Cricket World Cup 2021 in New Zealand till February - March 2022 because of the impact the Covid-19 pandemic has had on cricket globally. The format of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2021 will remain as it was for 2020 and all teams that qualified for that event will now participate in India in 2021. A new qualification process will be run for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2022. The format of the postponed ICC Women's Cricket World Cup will remain as it was for 2021. Five teams have already qualified for the event and that will stand for 2022.

income, the government has brought about long awaited amendments to the Essential Commodities Act, allowing farmers the freedom to produce, hold, move, distribute and supply their produce to markets across the country through e-platform so that they can harness maximum economic benefit. These moves are also expected to attract private sector and foreign direct investment into agriculture sector. It will help drive up investment in infrastructure and modernization of food supply chain. The government has decided to set up Agri-Infra Fund with Rs. One lakh crore to provide support to agricultural start-ups, entrepreneurs and agri-tech players for building new infrastructure and storage unit facilities for farm produce and allied activities. Following the motto of 'Annadata Sukhi Bhava', the government is also focusing on ensuring the access to technology till the last mile and making the farmers more competitive in the global value chain.

At the time of Independence, the industrial sector in India was under developed. However, the leadership of that time believed that rapid industrialization could ensure economic independence and economic sovereignty. A model of mixed economy was adopted in which public and private enterprises were developed and promoted. Mahalanobis model was followed to establish basic and capital goods industries on a large scale to create a strong base for the industrial development. Substantial investments were made in the Iron and Steel, Coal, Heavy engineering, Machine building, Heavy Chemicals and Cement Industries of basic importance. The first phase of Industrial development that included 1st three 5 year plans laid the foundation of a strong industrialization. The Post reform period, also termed as Fourth phase of Industrialization was a turning point.

In 1991, the government adopted a new economic policy. It decided to follow the path of economic liberalization, privatization and

globalization to improve the performance of the industrial sector and overall economy. This new policy triggered the beginning of the end of License Permit Raj and ushered major reforms. Foreign Direct Investments (FDI) was allowed to invest in the country whereas Public Sector Undertakings were disinvested.

The present government has accelerated the reform process. Recently the government relaxed FDI norms in a host of sectors including civil aviation, single-brand retail, defence and pharma by permitting more investments under automatic route. FDI norms have been eased in areas including e-commerce in food products, broadcasting carriage services, private security agencies and animal husbandry. Reform measures undertaken by the Government have resulted in increased FDI inflows at US\$ 55.46 billion in financial year 2015-16. Prime Minister has termed FDI as 'First Develop India'. The major focus of the reforms is to create employments and jobs.

The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) that contribute about 7-8 per cent of India's GDP, 45 per cent of the manufacturing output and 40 per cent of the exports, are at the top of the government's agenda. Recognised as the engine of growth for the economy, MSME employs the largest number of people after agriculture, and that is why the government has recently announced a series of reforms in this sector aimed to make India self-reliant. The present government has also undertaken the biggest tax reform since Independence in the form of Goods and Service Tax (GST) that has resulted in ease of trade, increased tax base and higher tax collections.

One of the biggest achievements of India since independence has been its rise as a Software Superpower. The service sector led by the software industry contributes highest in India's GDP. The government declared its IT policy in 1985 with focus on Electronics and

Software to address unemployment issue by offering a vast variety of jobs. India by virtue of its human resources took the lead in the IT software and services sector. Indian IT professionals reign the Silicon Valley. The tech giants including Google and Microsoft are headed by Indians. The latest figure claims that the export revenue of the Indian IT industry was over 130 billion U.S. dollars in the fiscal year 2019, and has increased at a faster rate in comparison to the domestic revenue across the country.

India has emerged as the third biggest electricity producer in Asia after over seven decades of Independence. As of 2019, it improved its capacity for electricity generation from 1,362 MW in 1947 to 356,818 MW.
