5G TECHNOLOGY TO SPUR ECONOMIC PROGRESS

People know about their belongings—house, car, furnitures, TV, refrigerator etc but how does it sound if you come to know that all your belongings know who their owner or the user is?

Our refrigerator will be able to sense when milk is about to get over and alert the milk vendor to deliver the required stock. Our home will be able to identify our footsteps, alongwith facial recognition, voice sensors when we enter and secure the premises when we exit.

Think of a farmer watering or monitoring his crop in early hours of cold winter mornings with help of drones without even getting out of his bed. Think of him ploughing his land with a tractor using a mobile phone application while he is on his way to sell his produce to a mandi.

These are some of the magical, rather transformational changes, the next generation telecom technology 5G will usher in to our world.

This will be an era of the Internet of Things (IoT), machine learning, artificial intelligence etc when all objects will be



able to communicate through broadband signals with each other with help of several sensors.

The world has already started shifting into the era of the emerging technologies with the help of 4G technology. However, the full potential of modern technologies can be realised only with the beginning of 5G.

4G Vs 5G

4G has changed our TV viewing experience, communicating with peers from voice call to video calls, business meetings on mobile etc. However the bandwidth available to provide 4G service is far less compared to bandwidth of 5G.

What makes 5G a transformational technology is the amount of computational

work that it can support over wireless networks with several fold more bandwidth compared to 4G.

At present, India can potentially deploy 4G in 8 spectrum frequency bands - 700 megahertz (MHz) band, 800 MHz band, 900 MHz band, 2100 MHz band, 2300 MHz band, 2500 MHz band and 2600 MHz band. Every band comprises around 100 MHz of frequencies. However, the signals become weak after a few kilometers and the same set of frequencies are reused by installing a mobile tower. India is divided in 22 telecom circles for the purpose of division and allocation of airwave frequencies. Hence the 800 MHz of frequencies are being reused across India on circle basis.

In the case of spectrum, signals cover more area in lower frequency bands i.e. in terms of numerical value. For example, mobile signals transmitted in 700 MHz band will cover three times more area than signals transmitted in 2100 MHz band.

When it comes to 5G, a high level panel set up under the Ministry of Telecom identified around 6000 MHz of radio waves

ROLE OF ACHIEVEMENT MOTIVATION IN REALIZATION OF GOALS

If you look around, you can easily find people who, though are in a similar age group, differ in respect of their achievements and accomplishments. There are students who are average in academics and also don't have any other accomplishment to mention. On the other hand, it is not difficult to find students whose academic performance is excellent and who are also good in sports or music or debating etc. This study can be extended to people of all age groups. You'll come across mothers who are playing their role exceedingly well and are also accomplished painter, dancer or theatre artist etc.

The above examples have been cited to explore answer to the question-why some people accomplish so much in life, while many others are not able to do much even when the situations for both is similar. From



accomplishments here we don't mean accumulation of wealth or physical assets. We are talking of something which may be personal but puts you in a different league because of its manifestation and social value. For example if someone writes poetry, she may be deriving immense satisfaction from it herself, while the poetry may be a source of inspiration and enjoyment for many others.

Coming back to the above

question, if somebody thinks that resources are the foundation of accomplishments, this answer is not convincing. There are so many people who have abundant resources but have no valuable accomplishments whereas people lacking in resources have proved to be significant achievers. Talent also is not the right answer. First, there is no specific or clear measurement of talent, and even if somebody is considered to be talented, it is not

necessary that she will prove to be achiever. When the board results are announced, we come across so many cases of boys and girls from poor and deprived backgrounds who were not considered talented, but did exceedingly well in the examination. Even if you see the profile of many candidates declared successful in recent civil services examination results, you'll find that they were far from being considered talented in traditional sense of the term.

Enough research has been done in the matter and it has been found that more than resource or talent, the motivation to do or accomplish something is the real foundation of success and achievement. Such motivation has been termed as achievement motivation. So, those who want to achieve something, need to have achievement motivation in the first place.

Motivation is the underlying reason for human behaviour. It comes in two forms—*intrinsic motivation* and *extrinsic motivation*. *Extrinsic motivation* comes from outside. You score well in examination and win appreciation from your teachers, family members and neighbours etc. which encourages you to do still better, is an example of *extrinsic motivation*. Getting inspired by someone to become like him or her, also comes under *extrinsic motivation*. One key feature of this motivation is that it is not available to everyone in equal measure. There has to be someone to influence, inspire or encourage you.

In comparison, *intrinsic motivation* can come without looking outside. It is not difficult to find people who, without receiving any external encouragement, keep pursuing their goals relentlessly. The fire to excel, to do or achieve something burns inside and keeps pushing the person in that direction. Also interesting is that for any *extrinsic motivation* to be fruitful, it has to get converted into its *intrinsic form*. A student may always be encouraged by parents to study hard for better future, but to really study hard the student needs to be committed herself. It may also happen that the student acts to be studying by keeping books before her but in fact is not attentive in study and is involved with some other thoughts.

There is a direct correlation between motivation and achievements. If someone doesn't put the required effort in a venture, it indicates lack of achievement motivation. As said earlier achievement motivation is a primary condition to really achieve something.

In today's times achievement is considered to be a key factor for personal and social advancement. The whole system of education involves around academic achievements of students in school, college or university etc. How one chooses one's career and navigates

through it, is also determined by the person's achievement motivation, though external factors always play their role.

Your achievement motivation shall be determined how you leverage your personality and immediate environment to fulfil your aspirations with efforts and persistence.

Let us first talk about which are the things that come in the way of our success or becoming an achiever. These may differ from person to person. As an individual, one has to identify which of these, if any, is applicable for her.

Procrastination: Procrastination means unnecessarily delaying execution of your plans. We may think and plan of so many things. But if we don't execute, those have no meaning. The plan may be related to anything—doing physical exercise, completing assignments etc. Procrastination isn't good for us. It harms us in multiple ways. Since we're stuck up with things which we don't implement, it becomes difficult to move on and take up something new, or move up to the next level. Also when we don't try and resultantly don't accomplish, it lowers our self-esteem and confidence.

Accepting defeat without trying: In many cases we already decide that a particular task is not possible for us to do and then there is no question of trying and making efforts. In fact, this is a dangerous situation because if everyone in the world had been thinking like that, individuals and the world had not progressed to this extent, and many of the inventions wouldn't have been possible. If you keep doubting about your abilities, even if you make a beginning in the right direction of your goals, the efforts made would be half hearted and inconsistent, lowering your chances of success.

Thinking that you don't have the resources: For every action in life, you need resources—be it a job search, preparation for a

competitive examination or starting a business etc. Resources may be in form of money, space, books, time etc. Here also if you conclude that you don't have the required resources, you've already lost half of the battle. Everyone in this world is not equally privileged or rich. But real success doesn't belong to only people fully equipped with resources. You may find large number of examples of people who despite their humble background and underprivileged status, could make big. The things to be kept in mind here is that resources can be generated and you need to make best use of the available resources. Worth remembering here is the valuable saying of our former president late A. P. J. Abdul Kalam that aspirations are greater than resources.

Not putting in your best: This is the age of competition and though there are abundant opportunities, one has to prove worthy of these. For this you've to give your best in whatever you do. When you make honest and dedicated efforts, the feeling and confidence you get become your prime rewards. Never give yourself an opportunity to regret that you didn't try enough. If you indeed want something, be strong and sincere in pursuit of it. Sometime people themselves are not honest in their efforts and blame other factors. Let this not happen in your case.

Now that we've talked about what you should get rid of to be more aligned to success, let us find out traits, habits etc. Which shall keep us in good stead when we want to achieve something.

Self-belief: If we want to achieve something, first we should've the belief that it is possible for us to achieve that. If anything is coming into your way, you need to make a self-analysis and bring the improvements which are needed. Each one of us has potential. Understanding it and strategically working towards realizing this potential will provide you satisfaction and fulfilment. Also let us accept the fact that none of us is perfect, we all are work in progress and in the process should always try to be better and move from one goal to the other and also keep learning from our mistakes.

Discipline: Discipline is something which is mostly

taught by our parents, elders and teachers. Now when we are grown up, we don't have to get lessons in it from others. We need to be self-disciplined. Discipline may appear to be difficult to follow, but it is for our own good and hence we need to master it. Knowing our priorities, sticking to it, not wasting our precious time and maintain good habits, all these are part of discipline. Don't mistake it for a regimented routine. An enjoyable life can be made more enjoyable with discipline.

Getting rid of the fear of failure: It is a simple fact that everyone is not going to succeed every time. Success and failures are both parts of life. Still many of us are not ready to accept or face failure. If somebody doesn't take a desired initiative due to fear of failure, it's a mistake. Take any competitive examination. If an ambitious young person is always afraid that she, despite her best efforts is not going to qualify in this, she herself would be considered responsible for this negative thought.

A person should definitely fight to win, but shouldn't be disheartened if desired results don't come. Failures need to be used as lesson for learning and improvement. If you read about great scientists, authors etc. you'll realize the truth behind this message.

Focus and determination: Focus and determination are highly crucial to achievements. In many cases, when a person has all the calibre and substance to succeed, being unfocused spoils the game. We should accept the fact that during our day to day routine, there would be distractions, but the challenge is to not get carried away by these and remain focused on our important goals. There should be continuity in efforts. Intermittently situations will come when you'd not be happy with your short term performance. Instead of getting disappointed, it'd be better if you analyse the reasons and ensure that these do not recur.

Creating proper environment: You get a given environment and there is one you create for yourself. For the latter, you have to take a few initiatives. For instance, if you want to learn playing guitar, it would always be good if you find one or more friends who too are interested in guitar. Joining a music club may also be of help. So, whichever area you choose, try to gather meaningful

references and support. It will need proactiveness on your part. You'll soon realize that this enabling environment is helpful to you and you derive emotional strength from it.

Review of progress: These days we're so preoccupied that there is hardly enough time to look back and objectively review our progress in whatever we've been doing. A periodic review is necessary to evaluate our progress in pursuance of our goal. This review should give us significant inputs to take our performance to the desired level. For example we may not have been good in time management or our pace of work has been too slow.

An achievement can be both big and small. So, one should not consider only getting a job or buying a car as an achievement. Sometimes smaller achievements may carry significant value.

Motivation to achieve is not equal for every goal. To explain, one may have higher motivation to cook than read a book. We shall choose to be motivated to do what we actually want to do. A cricket aficionado may not have any liking towards football though both are major sports.

Achievement motivation of people have made them to conquer Everest, create new Olympic records, produce great literary works and much more. Such people can be our role model.

To conclude, in order to live a life full of meaning, excitement, happiness and satisfaction, we need to define the things we really want to do and then, chart out a road map to accomplish these. However our ultimate success in realizing our goals would depend on our achievement motivation and only we can create such motivation.

5G TECHNOLOGY TO SPUR ECONOMIC PROGRESS

that can be used for the next generation technology compared to a set of 800 Mhz of radiowaves used in 4G.

The panel has spotted spectrum for 5G services across 11 bands of which 4 bands—premium 700 Mhz band, 3.5 gigahertz (Ghz), 24 Ghz and 28 Ghz band can be made immediately available for the service.

According to the 5G panel estimates 5,250 Mhz of spectrum can be made available for 5G services in higher frequency bands, 300 Mhz in 3.5 Ghz band and 405 Mhz spectrum in sub- 1000 Mhz.

At present the government has identified 300 Mhz of frequency between 3300-3600 Mhz range for 5G services. As per propagation behaviour of waves, the 5G signals will cover much smaller areas but with very high speed.

The nature of 5G technology is very different from 4G technology. It can be related to an example of a water pipe where the speed of water coming out of a thick pipe is slower than water coming out of thinner pipe.

The 5G technology will need special types of smaller mobile tower or points to transmit signals compared to base stations being deployed for 4G. Even the base stations (BTS) for 4G are smaller compared to BTS deployed for 2G. The 5G connectivity is considered to be more reliable compared to 4G because it will be able to connect devices almost like a dedicated connection.

Radiowaves in E band, which falls in 71-76 Ghz and 81-86 Ghz range, and V band, that is 57-64 Ghz, can transmit data at very high speeds and even replace optical fibre for short distance data transmission.

5G Roll Out

Globally over 100 commercial 5G networks have been rolled

out. This includes networks in the US, China, South Korea, Sweden, Finland, Germany, Canada, Brazil, Argentina, Saudi Arabia etc.

According to a mobile broadband analysis company, 5G networks are recording download speed of 377 megabit per second compared to around 30 mbps that consumers are getting on 4G networks. Ideally 5G technology is expected to deliver speed of 1 gigabit per second on wireless networks.

The telecom ministry in India had set a target in 2018 to roll out 5G in India by 2020 and also allocate spectrum to companies for conducting trials so that the country can deploy indigenous developed telecom gears in the network due to apprehensions around security. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi recently delivered the inaugural address at the virtual India Mobile Congress (IMC) 2020 through video conference. The theme for IMC 2020 was "Inclusive Innovation - Smart, Secure, Sustainable". It aims to align to the Prime Minister's vision to promote "Atmanirbhar Bharat", "Digital Inclusion", and "Sustainable development, entrepreneurship & innovation". It also aims to drive foreign and local investments, encourage R&D in the telecom and emerging technology sectors.

Addressing the event, the Prime Minister gave a call to work together to make India a global hub for telecom equipment, design, development and manufacturing. He cautioned that due to technological upgradation, we have a culture of replacing handsets and gadgets frequently. He asked the delegates to ponder whether the industry can form a task-force to think of a better way of handling the electronic waste and create a circular economy. He urged to work together to ensure a timely roll-out of 5G to leapfrog into the

future and empower millions of Indians.

Shri Modi said it is important to think and plan how to improve lives with the upcoming technology revolution. He added that better healthcare, better education, better information and opportunities for our farmers, better market access for small businesses are some of the goals that can be worked on.

He lauded the delegates from the telecom sector that the world was functional despite the pandemic due to their innovation and efforts. He added that due to their efforts that a son was connected with his mother in a different city, a student learnt from his teacher without being in the classroom, a patient consulted his doctor from his home and a trader connected with a consumer from a different geography.

The Prime Minister stressed that it is because of mobile technology that we are able to provide benefits worth billions of dollars to millions of Indians. We were able to help the poor and vulnerable quickly during the pandemic and we are seeing billions of cashless transactions which boost formalisation and transparency and we will also enable a smooth contactless interface on toll booths.

The Prime Minister said that the Government aims to bring high speed fibre-optic connectivity in every village over the next three years. He said that towards this end, focus is made exclusively on places which can make the best out of such connectivity - Aspirational Districts, Left wing extremism affected districts, North Eastern states, Lakshadweep Islands etc. He added that greater spread of fixed line broadband connectivity and public Wi-Fi hotspots will be ensured.

5G ecosystem readiness in India

Telecom companies in India claim to be 5G ready and are waiting for spectrum auction to buy radiowave frequencies to start rolling out the next generation technology.

However, the Department of Telecom, Department of Space and Defence Ministry are claiming their need for spectrum frequencies that have been identified for the 5G services.

The DoT identified a frequency band 3,300-3,600 Mhz band that can be used for 5G service but after the claims of Defence and ISRO, only 175 Mhz of radiowaves remain for mobile services. Telecom operators have said that they need at least 100 Mhz of spectrum per operator to roll out 5G service.

Mobile phone companies have started selling 5G ready phones

in India. Telecom network vendors like Nokia and Ericsson are making 5G equipment in India and are exporting to countries where commercial roll out of the network has started.

Reliance Jio has announced that it is developing in-house 5G technology. Due to non-availability of spectrum in India, the company's subsidiary Radsys is testing 5G solutions developed by it in the United States.

IT company Tech Mahindra and state-run telecom manufacturing firm ITI have partnered to develop indigenous 5G enabled devices, core systems etc.

Telecom operators have been demanding from the government to make available spectrum for 5G at the earliest and lower the reserve price.

Mobile service providers can start 5G services in India once suitable airwave frequencies are allotted to them by the government. Government allocates spectrum to telecom operators through the auction process. Spectrum auctions in India were held every year between 2012 to 2016. The next round of spectrum auction has been announced but it will not have 3300-3600 Mhz band frequencies.

TRAI had recommended base price of proposed 5G spectrum in 3,300-3,600 Mhz band at about Rs. 492 crore per Mhz unpaired spectrum on pan India basis.

Telecom operators interested in buying radiowaves for 5G will have to shell out close to Rs 50,000 crore for 100 megahertz of 5G spectrum required to deliver high speed broadband services.

SPECTRUM ISSUE

The DoT is learnt to have requested the Space Department and Defence Ministry to vacate airwaves in the medium and high range spectrum bands for rolling out 5G services. The DoT has requested the Defence Ministry to vacate 100 megahertz (Mhz) of spectrum in the frequency band of 3300-3400 Mhz and use frequencies in the 3000-3100 Mhz band. It has urged the DoS to vacate spectrum in the frequency band of 3600-3700 Mhz.

The DoS has raised concerns over possible interference of 5G signals in data collection by satellites for weather forecast which is crucial in the wake of climate change. The DoT had earlier accepted the demand of the space department to keep the 26 Ghz band, in which the 5G ecosystem has been developed, primarily for satellite services. The proposal was presented before the World Radiocommunication Conference in line with the demand of

the space department but the same was rejected by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).

According to Ericsson, 5G mobile services are expected to create an over USD 27 billion business opportunity for India by 2026. The next generation communications technology will help in meeting computational power requirements of emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning etc.

According to an industry estimate, AI holds potential to add over Rs 7,000 crore to the economy by 2035. However, it needs support of fast technologies like 5G for development of the ecosystem.

5G can also help in faster roll out of broadband in smaller towns as it has potential to provide speed on optical fibre network or wireless networks. This will enable telecom operators to connect households wirelessly without needing to dig trenches to lay telecom cables. The process to provide broadband through 5G will not only be cost saving but also it can be done expeditiously. However, the mobile towers in the country need to be connected with optical fibres to support 5G traffic.

India needs to expedite the process of availability of 5G spectrum for telecom companies as it has potential to unlock several activities that can contribute to our GDP and expedite the growth rate as well. NATIONAL

■ Prime Minister Modi stresses on broader agenda for global growth

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said societies that are open minded, democratic and transparent are better suited to innovate. Virtually addressing the 8th Indo-Japan SAMVAD Conference, the Prime Minister said, discussions on global growth cannot happen just between a few and stressed that the agenda must be broader and growth patterns must follow a human-centric approach. He envisioned that this decade and beyond will belong to those societies that place a premium on learning and innovating together. Innovation is the corner-stone to human empowerment and true learning should promote innovation.



■ Surveillance & Response measures for new variant of SARS-CoV 2

Health Ministry has issued Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Epidemiological Surveillance and Response for a new variant of SARS-CoV 2 virus, which has been reported by the UK government to World Health Organization (WHO). This variant is estimated by European Center for Disease Control (ECDC) to be more transmissible and affecting younger population. This variant is defined by a set of 17 changes or mutations. One of the most significant mutation is in the spike protein that the virus uses to bind to the human ACE2 receptor. Change in this part of the spike protein may result in the virus becoming more infectious and spreading more easily between people.

■ Welfare of farmers & agriculture industry at the core of Centre's initiatives

Information and Broadcasting Minister Prakash Javadekar has said the government is doing its best to bring about emerging technologies in agriculture by upgrading the National e-Governance Project for Agriculture (NeGPA). In a tweet, Mr. Javadekar said the welfare of farmers and the agriculture industry is at the core of all these initiatives by the Centre.



■ BJP emerges largest single party winning 74 seats in J&K DDC elections

In Jammu and Kashmir Union Territory, out of 280 District Development Council DDC constituencies, result of 276 seats has been declared. BJP is lead the tally with 74 seats followed closely by J&K National Conference with 67 seats. Independents have won 49 seats, Mehbooba Mufti's Peoples Democratic Party 27, Indian National Congress 26 while J&K Apni Party has bagged 12 seats and J&K People's Conference 8 seats. CPI(M) has got 5 seats while JKPM bagged 3 seats and J&K National Panthers Party and PDF won two seats each. Bahujan Samaj party(BSP) won one seat.

■ Post matric scholarships for over 4 crore Scheduled Caste students

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved Rs. 59,048 crore post matric scholarship scheme for more than four crore Scheduled Castes students in 5 years. Briefing media, Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Thawarchand Gehlot said, the Central Government will spend Rs. 35,534 crore for it which is 60 per cent and the balance 40 per cent will be spent by the State Governments. It is estimated that 1.36 crore such poorest students, who are currently not continuing their education beyond 10th standard would be brought into the higher education system in the next 5 years.



ECONOMY

■ Measures to curb menace of fake GST invoice by fraudsters

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has said that the government has issued a notification to curb the menace of fake GST invoice by fraudsters or fly-by-right

firms. She said, the move comes following recommendations of the GST Council's Law Committee in this regard. Ms Sitharaman said, the GST laws passed by the Parliament and state legislatures provide that GST registration is liable to be cancelled for those who have not filed 6 or more returns.

■ FDI policies being made more facilitative, congenial and supportive

Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal has said that there is tremendous scope for Australian investment into India as India has eased its FDI norms and opened up different sectors. Addressing the CII session on Enhancing India-Australia Bilateral Economic and Trade Relationship on 18 December, Mr Goyal said that India has also opened up the Agri sector for greater investments in food processing and value addition. He also launched India-Australia Economic Strategy Report.

■ EPFO net subscribers rise 56% to 11.55 lakh in October

The provisional payroll data of EPFO released, reveals that EPFO has added 11.55 lakh net subscribers in the month of October this year. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, EPFO has added around 39.33 lakh subscribers during the current financial year from April to October, 2020. The data published comprises of members who have joined during the month and whose contribution has been received by EPFO for the wage month. Year-on-year comparison shows that October, 2020 has registered a healthy 56 per cent growth in terms of net payroll addition as compared to net subscriber growth of 7.39 lakh registered during October last year, indicating robust recovery to pre Covid-19 levels. In October 2020, around 7.15 lakh new members have joined EPFO and approximately 2.40 lakh members exited. Gender-wise analysis shows that around 2.09 lakh net female subscribers were added during October 2020. Women contributed around 21 per cent of the new subscribers for October 2020.

INTERNATIONAL

■ Protests across Balochistan against killing of Karima Baloch in Canada

Protest rallies were carried out in different cities across Balochistan against the killing of prominent leader and activist Karima Baloch in Canada. Hundreds of people including activists gathered in various places in Quetta and Hub City demanding a fair probe by the Canadian government into Karima's sudden death. Karima, a vocal critic of the Pakistan Army and government atrocities in Balochistan, was found dead in Toronto. The Baloch activist had arrived in Canada in 2016 and campaigned extensively against disappearances and human rights violations in the troubled Balochistan province.



■ Nepal Parliament dissolved, two phases polls in April and May 2021

Nepal President Bidhya Devi Bhandari dissolved parliament at the request of Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli's cabinet. President's office said in a statement that the elections will be held on April 30 and May 10, 2021, more than a year ahead of schedule. Amid rising intra-party rift, Nepal Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli recommended to the President to dissolve the parliament at an emergency meeting of the Cabinet.

■ Four indigenous sports included in Khelo India Youth Games 2021

The Sports Ministry has approved the inclusion of four indigenous Games to be a part of Khelo India Youth Games 2021, scheduled to take place in Haryana. The games include, Gatka, Kalaripayattu, Thang-Ta and Mallakhamba. Speaking about the decision, Sports Minister Kiren Rijju said, India has a rich heritage of indigenous sports and it is a priority for the Sports Ministry to preserve, promote and popularise these games. He said, there is no better platform than the Khelo India Games where athletes of these games can compete.
