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JOB OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NORTH EAST

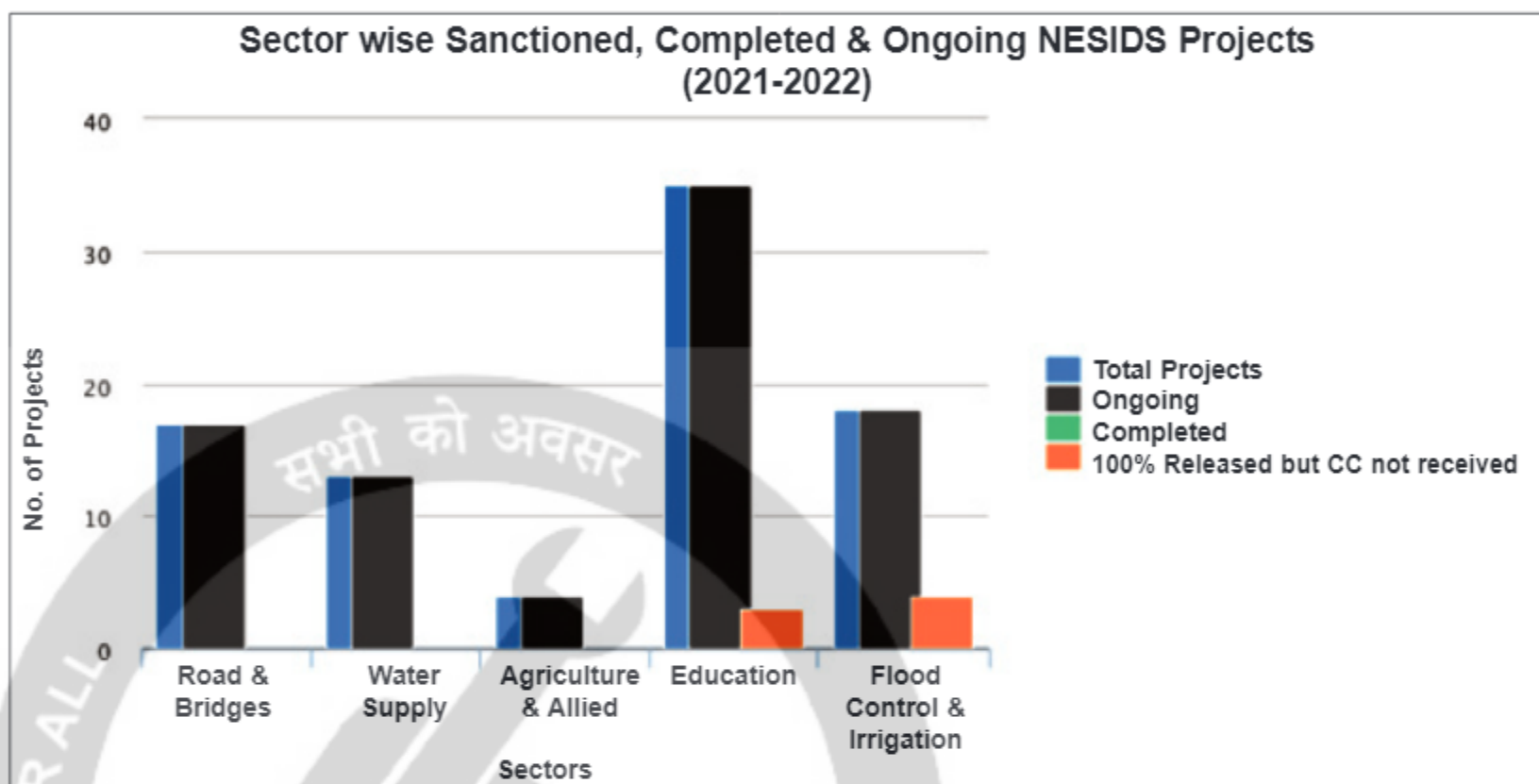

India's North Eastern Region (NER) constitutes approximately 7.9 per cent of the country's total population, and 3.6 per cent of its total workforce, according to the 2011 Census. The region, includes eight states, namely Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura.

The NER has been historically under developed. This was due to a lack of appropriate infrastructure, poor governance, low productivity, and insufficient market access owing to its geographical conditions.

Facing a slower pace of industrialisation and socio-economic growth, the North Eastern Region had not been adequately integrated within India's growth story. Low levels of business engagement and a poor focus on local competence building and partnerships amongst development agencies led to a neglect of this highly lucrative region.

However, as of late, the growth potential of the North Eastern Region is being increasingly recognized. Endowed with a wide variety of natural resources, the presence of a large workforce, and



connectivity to countries to the East of India, all prove to provide an exceptional space for focussing growth and development strategies.

India's commitment to realizing its goal of becoming a USD 5 Trillion economy

requires the inculcation of the North East in its growth story. The government has undertaken a number of schemes in this regard, which directly or indirectly will drive an overhaul of the employment scenario in the region.

North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS)

The NESIDS was approved by the Government of India as a centrally sponsored scheme in the year 2017.

A Nuclear Engineer will typically do the following:

- Design or develop nuclear equipment, such as reactor cores, radiation shielding, or associated instrumentation
- Manage staff and budgets for complex design, construction, maintenance, expansion, safety, and decommissioning projects
- Monitor nuclear facility operations to identify any design, construction, or operation practices that violate safety regulations and laws
- Examine nuclear accidents and gather data that can be used to design preventive measures
- Write operational instructions to be used in nuclear plant operation or in handling and disposing of nuclear waste
- Direct maintenance activities of operational nuclear power



plants to ensure that they meet safety standards

- Perform experiments to test whether methods of using nuclear material, reclaiming nuclear fuel, or disposing of nuclear waste are acceptable
- Take corrective actions or order plant shutdowns in emergencies
- Nuclear Engineers are also on the forefront of developing uses of nuclear material for

medical imaging devices, such as positron emission tomography (PET) scanners. They also may develop or design cyclotrons that produce a high-energy beam that the healthcare industry uses to treat cancerous tumors.

ELIGIBILITY

Various courses in Nuclear Engineering & Technology are offered by different university

departments and research institutes at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

Nuclear Engineering is based on the principle of nuclear physics which is taught in various colleges, universities, and research institutes. Nuclear Engineering & Technology provides knowledge about uses of nuclear fission, construction, design, processing and management of nuclear reactors as well as invention of nuclear materials. Academic programs offered through universities and research institutes focus on all areas of nuclear energy, i.e. research, development and application.

Under this, the scheme provides 100 per cent central funding to the state governments of each of the eight states in the North East region in order to carry out infrastructure development projects.

Skill India Mission

Institutionalised interactions between Central and State leaders is essential to bringing the opportunities and initiatives to skill building to people across the country.

The Prime Minister's Skill India Mission exemplifies the commitment towards upskilling India's workforce in order to help them become active, contributing members of society. This initiative has allowed the youth across the nation to realize their potential.

Schemes like Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK), Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Apprenticeship, Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) are important to build the employment capacity of states in the North East.

The Skill India Mission has achieved immense success in the NER as of 2019. Since their launch in 2016, these schemes have helped over 2.5 lakh youths to get training, out of which 1.82 lakhs have been certified. More than 80 thousand artisans practicing traditional art and handicrafts have had their skills certified under the PMKVY. 103 PM Kaushal Kendras have been allotted in the region, which act as multi-skill institutions to improve the employability of the youths in the North East. These are in high-demand and high-skill areas such as retail, tourism, music, health care, etc.

The women of the North East have also received special attention in the form of the setting up of a National Skill Training Institute (NSTI) for skilling women non-traditional roles and improving gender-sensitivity in the workplace. Over 250 women from the Bru Tribe have been trained under PMKVY 2.0, as well as gained employment.

The MSDE also set up the National Entrepreneurship Awards Scheme for the years 2016 to 2021 as a means of incentivizing and providing due recognition to the exceptional efforts of first-generation entrepreneurs across the country. Entrepreneurship has been promoted in the region, with several initiatives aimed at arming the youth with the necessary skillset. This achievement is evidenced by over 214 applications for the 2018 National Entrepreneurship Awards being from the North East. The Awards had 33 winners, of which five were from the North East, and of these, three were women.

The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship set up the National Council for Vocational Education and Training in the region, which is a skills regulator that merges existing bodies like the National Skill Development Agency and National Council for Vocational Training, and helps further intensify efforts of skilling and ensuring they are well targeted.

The PM-YUVA initiative, which was implemented in the year 2017, has aided in entrepreneurship education and training across the country via the Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL). Six of these IHLs belonging to the North East were a part of this scheme, through which over 684 students have received formal entrepreneurship training in the year 2017-18.

In 2019, leaders from the states of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, and Nagaland met with representatives of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. The schemes implemented in all eight states of the region were analyzed, and the challenges facing their implementation were discussed. As envisioned by the Prime Minister, the goal of reaching out to 2.5 lakh youth was successful, and further goals to enhance infrastructure and management of structures and processes were identified.

In an effort to analyze and strengthen the network of ITIs and NSTIs in the North East Region, it was found that there were 73 ITIs with a capacity of 17,000, with 13,000 dedicated to engineering or technical fields like electricians, auto-mechanics, and others, wherein there was a shortage of trainers as well as adequate training facilities. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship declared that an NSTI would be set up in the region, and INR 60 lakhs would be released to upgrade the training equipment in Manipur.

In order to combat the issue of large-scale migration of labour from the North Eastern states as people look to find better opportunities for employment due to lack of adequate employment in the region, it was also decided that there would be a renewed policy focus on creating short term courses in the field of running local trade.

The potential and passion held by the people from the North East Region is important to be harnessed and developed, so as to bring true development to the region. Central and State government engagement in promoting the Skill India Mission is therefore essential to achieving this feat.

National Recruitment Agency

The National Recruitment Agency (NRA) was set up in order to create a common

preliminary examination for various recruitments in the central government.

The youths of the North Eastern Region were encouraged to become aware of the opportunities that the NRA provides, in securing government jobs, as part of a webinar conducted by Press Information Bureau.

The NRA will focus on setting up recruitment centers even in the backward areas of North East India, which will be of immense help to the youth who were unable to seek employment due to difficulties in travelling to far away recruitment centers. A common eligibility test will replace the burden of numerous tests.

Bringing examination centers to these remote areas of the NER, which have historically faced neglect, will be highly invaluable in allowing the students in the region to secure jobs they deserve due to their accomplishments, without facing the hassle of poor connectivity and accessibility.

North East BPO Promotion Scheme (NEBPS)

Recognising the immense potential that lies in India's IT-BPM industry, with its strong foundation and space for further growth, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology launched the NEBPS as part of the Digital India Initiative.

Most revenue in the IT-BPM industry is generated in and around the Tier-1 metropolitan hubs such as Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Delhi NCR, Chennai, Mumbai, Pune and Kolkata, leaving a large pool of talented youth in other regions of the country, and specifically the North East Region. The objective of the scheme was to create 1.5 lakh direct jobs, and a larger number of indirect jobs, for the local youth in the smaller towns in the country which lacked formal employment opportunities. The idea was also to attract investment in these regions to aid overall development. The Software Technology Parks of India is the nodal agency in the implementation of this scheme.

The NEBPS seeks to incentivize the establishment of 5,000 seats for IT-BPO operations specifically in the North East Region, with an aim of generating 15,000 direct jobs considering three shift operations, as well as a large number of indirect jobs. The number of allocated seats stood at 3,511as of March 2021.

Bringing IT and BPO opportunities to the North East, the NEBPS is creating impacts including lower cost of operations, generation employment, promoting skill development, enabling inclusion of women in the workforce, and upscaling the local SME sector. Financial support is offered as a special incentive to BPOs

employing women and persons with disability. It is also provided for the units setting up BPO operations as a consortium with local entrepreneurs.

North Eastern Development Finance Corporation (NEDFi)

The NEDFi plays an integral role in helping budding entrepreneurs in the region, supporting the NER's ecosystem by facilitating, nurturing, financing and promoting entrepreneurship and growth of enterprises in the area.

The NEDFi provides financial assistance to Micro, Small, Medium and Large enterprises to set up their industrial infrastructure and agriculture allied projects in the North East. It also offers consultancy and advisory services, conducts state specific studies under the Techno-Economic Development Fund, and conducts promotional activities.

The North East Venture Fund, (NEVF) established by the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region in collaboration with the NEDFi, stands as the first, and sole venture fund for the North East, with an initial corpus of INR 100 crores. It targets startups and unique business opportunities, particularly in the area of food processing, healthcare, tourism, segregation of services, IT, etc. The NEVF was set up with the mission to improve livelihoods and create opportunities for the youth of the North East Region who wished to explore the various areas of untapped potential in the North East.

The investment size with the Venture Fund Scheme falls between the range of INR 2.5 lakhs and 10 crores, with a long-term horizon of five to ten years.

Bamboo Industry

The diversity in India's cultures and traditions across states have historically reflected in the variety of trades in which individuals in each state are engaged in. A variety of climatic and geographical conditions spurred the existence of a wide variety of resources in the country. One highly important, economically and commercially viable, valuable resource found primarily in India's North East

Region is that of bamboo. Around 35 per cent of area under bamboo cultivation is in the North East.

Considering the fact that India is home to the largest area under cultivation with bamboo and around 136 different varieties of bamboo, there lies enormous potential in developing the resource for domestic as well as global demands. Bamboo happens to be one of the most versatile crops, which can be used in the manufacturing of furniture, building homes, accessories and handicrafts, and even highly nutritious food items.

The presence of such immense potential for bamboo-based industries also indicates the ability to create thousands of new jobs for those in the North East.

National Bamboo Mission

The versatile nature of bamboo, its ease of cultivation in Indian climates, as well as its potential to impact numerous rural livelihoods make it a highly important resource to focus on and nurture. The National Bamboo Mission, launched as a sub-scheme within the Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture, seeks to harness this very potential.

With an objective of holistic development of the bamboo industry, the National Bamboo Mission aims to be the connecting link between the industry and the producers. The strategy adopted for the promotion of bamboo cultivation involved the adoption of area-based regional differentiation. This would not only increase the area under bamboo cultivation, but also enhance the quality and strength of the crop and the

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Highlights of PM's Mann ki Baat on 28.3.2021

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has reiterated on the Mantra of 'Dawai bhi, Kadai bhi' to fight Corona. Sharing his thoughts in the Mann Ki Baat programme of All India Radio on March 28, 2021, he appealed to the people to remain committed to this Mantra. He also appealed to every eligible person to take the Covid-19 vaccine. Mr Modi said, it's a matter of honour for everyone that today India is running the world's largest vaccination programme.

The Prime Minister said that last year in March the country heard the term Janata Curfew for the first time. It was an unprecedented example of discipline and generations to come will certainly feel proud of that.

The Prime Minister recalled that the Amrit Mahotsav to mark 75 years of Independence began from the day of Dandi Yatra and will continue till 15th August, 2023. He urged citizens to bring to fore the saga of freedom fighters and the historical and cultural importance of a place during Amrit Mahotsav to connect the country.

The Prime Minister said, the Amrit Mahotsav of our freedom implies that we make new resolves and to realize those resolves, we persevere with the freedom wholeheartedly with due diligence. It should be meant for the welfare of society, for the good of the country and for a bright future. He said, the resolve should be in sync with the duties and responsibilities of the citizens.

The Prime Minister said, the Women's Day in March, came at a time when many women players set new records and won medals. He cited the example of Mithali Raaj who has become the first Indian



woman cricketer to score ten thousand runs in international cricket.

The Prime Minister lauded India's excellent performance at the ISSF World Cup shooting in New Delhi where it topped the Gold Medals tally. Mr. Modi spoke how P V Sindhu won the Silver Medal in the BWF Swiss Open Super 300 Tournament.

The Prime Minister called for novelty and modernization in all fields of life, otherwise it becomes a burden at times. In this context, he said that modernization in the field of Indian agriculture is the need of the hour. He emphasized the need to adopt new alternatives and new innovations, along with traditional farming to create new opportunities for employment in the agriculture sector.

The Prime Minister talked about how bee farming is becoming the foundation of a honey revolution or sweet revolution in the country. He cited the example of a

village Gurdum in Darjeeling, West Bengal where despite steep mountains and geographical problems, people have started honey bee farming.

In addition to honey, the bee wax is also a very big source of income. The Prime Minister said that currently India imports bee wax, but, our farmers are now rapidly transforming this situation and in a way contributing in the Aatmanirbhar Bharat campaign.

Mr Modi highlighted that the light houses are unique in terms of tourism and their grand structures have always been centres of attraction for people. He said, to promote tourism, 71 light houses have been identified in India. These light houses will be equipped with museums, amphitheatres, open air theatres, cafeterias, children parks, eco-friendly cottages and landscaping depending upon their capacity. The Prime Minister paid homage to the hard working light

keepers on the 10 years of the horrifying tsunami that hit Japan and the one that hit India in 2004. India had lost 14 of the employees working at the light houses.

Speaking about World Sparrow Day, Mr Modi said, in Varanasi, Indrapal Singh Batra has initiated a noble effort and turned his house into a home for the Goraiya. Today many homes in Benaras are joining this campaign. The Prime Minister said, for nature, environment, animals and birds, small or big efforts should be made.

The Prime Minister mentioned Bijay Kumar Kabiji from Kendrapada in Odisha who in 12 years has raised a 25-acre mangrove forest on the outskirts of his village towards the sea. He also spoke about Amresh Samant who has planted micro- forests, which are protecting many villages. Mr Modi mentioned Marimuthu Yoganathan who works as a bus conductor in Coimbatore in Tamil Nadu.

Mr Modi said, we have to work really hard to enrich the immense cultural heritage around us and to pass it on to the new generation. He spoke about Sikari Tissau of Karbi Anglong district of Assam, who has been documenting the Karbi language for the last 20 years.

The Prime Minister greeted people for Holi, New Year Celebrations of Ugadi, Tamil Puthandu, Gudi Padwa, Bihu, Navreh, Poila Boishakh, Baisakhi and Vishu, Navratri, Ram Navmi, Easter and Ambedkar Jayanti.

Speaking about the programme, Mann ki Baat which completed 75 episodes, Mr Modi thanked all the listeners for making it a success, enriching it and staying connected.

Following the ideals of 'Make in India', encouraging bamboo cultivation within India would also help reduce the need to import bamboo products, helping indigenous producers.

Reform in the Indian Forest Act, 1927

The potential of bamboo cultivation in the NER was not being adequately utilized due to restrictions in the transportation and movement of bamboo under the Indian Forest Act of 1927. The government, in the year 2017, removed bamboo from the classification of tress in the Act, reclassifying it as grass.

This decision has completely changed the game for developing the bamboo sector that is so lucrative to the North Eastern States. This is because now, it is possible for anyone to undertake bamboo cultivation as well as do business in its production and sale without felling and transit permissions.

Import Duties on Bamboo

In 2020, the government also gave a big boost to indigenous agarbatti and bamboo-based industries by increasing the import duty on bamboo. Import duty on bamboo, which was most often imported from China and Vietnam, was increased from 10 per cent to 25 per cent.

The chairman of Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), V.K. Saxena said that this hike will curb such heavy imports from China and incentivize local manufacturing. He stated that he expects this will help India become 'aatmanirbhar' in agarbatti manufacturing, and also lead to the creation of thousands of new jobs.

Bamboo Clusters

In order to enhance export and manufacture of bamboo products, the Central Government launched 22 bamboo clusters in nine states across the country. Of these, Assam, Nagaland and Tripura represented the North East.

Five clusters are located in Tripura, two in Nagaland, and one in Assam. The objective of these clusters is to promote the production of bamboo products as well as generate green jobs. This helps sustain the local economy and communities and

drive economic prosperity in these regions as they make use of resources readily available in their states.

Tourism and Hospitality

In 2019, India's travel and tourism sector contributed around USD 194.3 Billion to the country's GDP. The sector contributed, before covid-19, around 8.1 per cent of the jobs, employing around 42 Million people. It accounted for about 6.8 per cent of the country's GDP, and 5.9 per cent of total investments flowed into it. Some estimates suggest that the sector can 'accelerate to 9-10 per cent annual growth and add millions of high-quality jobs each year'.

Tourism and travel are important because it is a major job creator and some estimates suggest that by 2029, it would account for about 53 Million jobs, increasing from 43 Million in 2018, which accounted for over 8 per cent of total employment in the country. The North East Tourism Development Council was set up in Shillong in 2017 with the aim of promoting tourism in the region.

Some of the employment opportunities in the field of tourism include:

Tourist Guides: Providing assistance and information on the cultural, historical and social significance of the various sites in the North East is a highly lucrative job.

Tourism

Officers and staff in tourism departments for state and central governments have stable jobs obtained via the civil service and other selection processes. This requires a degree in travel and tourism.

Airlines: A degree in travel and tourism or hotel management can help obtain employment as traffic assistance, reservation and counter staff, sales and marketing staff, etc.

Travel Agencies: With the wide variety of tourist destinations in the North East, travel agencies help guide and manage the best travel and stay options for tourist.

Since careers in these fields often require the employee to possess a degree in related fields, some of the courses related to tourism are Advanced Diplomas in Travel and Tourism Management, MBA Travel and Tourism, Post Graduate Diploma in Travel and Tourism Management, Bachelor of Tourism Studies, etc. These courses are available in a number of Institutes, such as the Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management, which is an autonomous body under the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India. IITTM offers education, training, research and consultancy in sustainable management of tourism, travel and allied sectors.

Department:

The Union Budget for 2021-22 introduced a new centrally sponsored scheme that is expected to facilitate growth of the tourism industry. This scheme, known as the Development of Iconic Tourist Destinations, has identified 19 iconic sites in the country to help develop in a holistic manner. One of these 19 iconic destinations identified is the Kaziranga National Park in Assam. This means that immense focus will be given to building appropriate infrastructure, use of technology, and attracting private investment by enhancing branding and marketing to this tourist destination, thus facilitating the creation of more jobs in the sector, directly and indirectly.

In recent years, there has been an increasing focus, and indeed rediscovery of the beauty and opportunities in northeast India, and with this increased attention, job opportunities in the area have mushroomed. The northeast of India is set to become a major engine of India's growth story providing meaningful and exciting employment to millions.

NATIONAL

■ Vaccination starts for citizens above 45 years of age

Covid-19 vaccination started for everyone aged above 45 years from April 1, irrespective of co-morbidity. People born before 1st January 1977 are eligible for this phase of vaccination. The co-morbidities clause has been removed to make the system simpler. All persons of 45 years and above can register themselves in the CoWIN System for booking of appointment for vaccination. Onsite registration will also be permissible. People can go to their nearest vaccination centre after 3 PM for on-site registration with any identity document. If a beneficiary has taken an online appointment for vaccination on CoWIN then there is no need to take any further appointment at Private or Public hospitals. If any hospital does not follow these guidelines of vaccination, then one must lodge a complaint at toll-free number 1075.



■ Jal Jeevan Mission deploys first-of-its-kind sensor-based IoT devices to monitor rural drinking water supply system

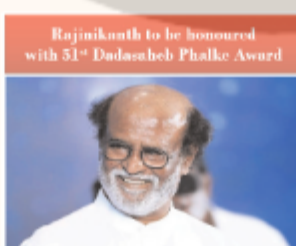
To monitor the rural drinking water supply system in villages, the Ministry of Jal Shakti has decided to take the digital route to use sensor-based IoT devices to effectively monitor the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in more than six lakh villages. For this, National Jal Jeevan Mission in collaboration with Tata Community Initiatives Trust (TCIT) and Tata Trusts recently completed pilot projects in several remote villages of Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Himachal Pradesh. A key feature of these pilots has been the use of frugal yet sturdy sensors, which makes the solution scalable and sustainable.

■ Atal Innovation Mission launches 'AIM-PRIME'

In a major push towards deep technology and driving the country to become a digitally transformed nation, Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog launched AIM-PRIME (Program for Researchers on Innovations, Market-Readiness & Entrepreneurship), an initiative to promote and support science-based deep-tech startups & ventures across India. In this regard, AIM has joined hands with Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF) to launch this nationwide programme which will be implemented by Venture Center - a non-profit technology business incubator. The first cohort of the programme is open to technology developers (early-stage deep tech start-ups, and scientists/ engineers/ clinicians) with strong science-based deep tech business ideas. The programme is also open to CEOs and Senior incubation managers of AIM Funded Atal Incubation Centers that are supporting deep tech entrepreneurs.

■ Rajinikanth to be honoured with 51st Dadasaheb Phalke Award

Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting Shri Prakash Javadekar announced the recipient of the 51st Dadasaheb Phalke Award. The award for 2019 will be conferred to legendary actor Rajinikanth. It will be presented on 3rd May, along with the National Film Awards. The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi congratulated Rajinikanth after he was chosen for the Dadasaheb Phalke Award.



■ Noted Marathi writer Dr. Sharankumar Limbale to receive Saraswati Samman 2020

Noted Marathi writer Dr Sharankumar Limbale will receive Saraswati Samman, 2020 for his book Sanatan. The award carries Rs. 15 lakh, a citation and a plaque. Saraswati Samman, instituted by K K Birla Foundation in 1991, is recognised as the most prestigious and highest literary award in the country. Dr Limbale's *Sanatan* has been published in 2018. *Sanatan* is an important social and historical document of dalit struggle.

INTERNATIONAL

■ India-Mauritius Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement enters into force

India and Mauritius signed the Comprehensive Economic Cooperation and Partnership Agreement (CECPA) on February 22, 2021. The CECPA is the first trade Agreement signed by India with a country in Africa. Both sides have completed their internal legal procedures and the India-Mauritius CECPA entered into force on April 1, 2021. The agreement covers Trade in Goods, Rules of Origin, Trade in Services, Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT), Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) measures, Dispute Settlement, Movement of Natural Persons, Telecom, Financial services, Customs Procedures and Cooperation in other Areas. The India-Mauritius CECPA provides for an institutional mechanism to encourage and improve trade between the two countries.

■ Relief to Indian IT Professionals as US allows H-1B visa ban to expire

The U.S. ban on foreign workers visa, specially H-1B has expired. US President Joe Biden allowed the ban notification issued by his predecessor Donald Trump to expire as its validity lapsed on 31st March 2021. This is being considered a big relief for thousands of Indian IT professionals.



Former US President Donald Trump had issued a proclamation in June last year suspending entry to the US of applicants for several temporary or non-immigrant visa categories, including H-1B. The ban was extended to March 31, 2021. Trump had said, that an extension is needed as the pandemic continued to disrupt American's lives, and high levels of unemployment and job loss and serious economic challenges to workers across the US. President Biden did not issue a fresh proclamation for the ban on H-1B visas to continue after March 31.

■ 2000 Bangladeshi students to get Mukti Joddha Scholarships

The government of India has announced scholarships to 2000 descendants of the Liberation War fighters of Bangladesh under its new Mukti Joddha Scholarship scheme. The scheme was launched in 2017 during the visit of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to India. According to a press release issued by the High Commission of India in Dhaka, 1000 students each from the Higher Secondary and Undergraduate categories have started receiving the amount of scholarship directly in their account. The new scheme was aimed to benefit 10,000 students from Bangladesh over a period of five years. The scholarship carries an amount of 20,000 Taka for students of Higher Secondary and 50,000 Taka to Undergraduate category students, who are direct descendants of Mukti Joddhas or Liberation War fighters of Bangladesh.

ECONOMY

■ NITI Aayog Releases Report on Investment Opportunities in India's Healthcare Sector

NITI Aayog has released a report outlining the range of investment opportunities in various segments of India's healthcare sector, including hospitals, medical devices and equipment, health insurance, telemedicine, home healthcare and medical value travel. The report was released by NITI Aayog Member Dr VK Paul, CEO Amitabh Kant, and Additional Secretary Dr Rakesh Sarwal. India's healthcare industry has been growing at a Compound Annual Growth Rate of around 22% since 2016. At this rate, it is expected to reach USD 372 billion in 2022. Healthcare has become one of the largest sectors of the Indian economy, in terms of both revenue and employment. As per estimates by the National Skill Development Corporation, Healthcare can generate 27 lakh additional jobs in India between 2017-22.

■ Reserve Bank lowers base rate by 15 basis points at 7.81 per cent; Loans by NBFCs and MFIs to be cheaper

Various loans offered by Non-Banking Finance Companies (NBFC) and Micro Finance Institutes (MFI) are expected to be cheaper from April 1. Reserve Bank has communicated that the applicable base rate to be charged as 7.81 per cent. It is lower by 15 basis points as compared to last quarter. During the same period last year it was 8.76. On the last working day of every quarter, RBI advises interest rates to be charged by NBFC-MFIs to their borrowers in the ensuing quarter. It is based on the average of the base rates of the five largest commercial banks.

■ Cabinet approves Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry

The Union Cabinet has approved the Central Sector Scheme - "Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry (PLISFPI)" to support creation of global food manufacturing champions commensurate with India's natural resource endowment and support Indian brands of food products in the international markets with an outlay of Rs. 10900 crore.

SPORTS

■ Rishabh Pant replaces injured Shreyas Iyer as Captain of Delhi Capitals for upcoming IPL

Rishabh Pant has been appointed as the Delhi Capitals captain for this year IPL as Shreyas Iyer was ruled out of the season after he dislocated his left shoulder during ODI series against England. This is the first captaincy assignment for Pant in the IPL, who was bought by the Capitals before the 2016 IPL and then became the first player to be retained ahead of the 2018 mega auction. 23 year old Pant will become the fifth-youngest captain in the IPL after Virat Kohli, Steven Smith, Suresh Raina and Iyer.
